

आज कल के प्रदूषित वातावरण व भागदौड़ भरी जिंदगी में योग को ही निरोग रहने का सबसे बेहतरीन साधन माना जाता है।

विगत नौ वर्षों से प्रतिवर्ष 22 जून को हम अंतर्राष्ट्रीय योग दिवस मनाते आ रहे हैं। इस वर्ष सिर्फ भारत में ही नहीं अपितु 180 देशों में भी योग दिवस बड़े ही उत्साह के साथ एक पर्व के रूप में मनाया गया। इस वर्ष आयुष मंत्रालय द्वारा योग दिवस 2023 के लिए ‘वसुधैव कुटुंबकम के सिद्धांत पर योग’ विषय वस्तु (थीम) का चयन किया गया। हमारे लिए यह अत्यंत हर्ष का विषय है कि इस वर्ष हमारे शहर (संस्कारधानी) जबलपुर के गैरिसन ग्राउंड में राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर योग दिवस का उत्सव आयोजित किया गया। साथ ही शहर के अन्य विद्यालयों व कार्यालयों में भी योग दिवस बड़े ही जोश और उत्साह के साथ मनाया गया।

गैरिसन ग्राउंड में माननीय उपराष्ट्रपति जगदीप धनकड़ जी, माननीय राज्यपाल गंगू भाई पटेल जी माननीय मुख्यमंत्री शिवराज सिंह चौहान जी, अन्य मंत्रीगण व लगभग 15,000 प्रतियोगियों ने हिस्सा लिया। इस कार्यक्रम में हमारी शाला के 50 छात्र छात्राओं ने श्रीमती सुनीता नामदेव मैडम, श्री विकास चंद्र यादव सर व श्री शुभम ठाकुर सर के मार्गदर्शन में पूरे जोश व उत्साह के साथ भाग लिया। इसी जोश व उत्साह को कायम रखते हुए शाला के शेष विद्यार्थियों ने भी। शाला प्रांगण में श्रीमती आशा मालविया मैडम व श्रीमती लता राव के मार्गदर्शन में आयुष मंत्रालय के द्वारा निर्धारित किए गए प्रोटोकोल के तहत समस्त शाला परिवार के साथ योग किया। इसके लिए दिनांक 16 / 06 / 23 से 21 / 06 / 23 तक बच्चों को शाला में ही प्रशिक्षित किया गया था। मैं उन सभी अभिभावकों का हृदय से धन्यवाद देना चाहती हूँ, जिन्होंने इस कार्यक्रम को सफल बनाने में पूर्ण सहयोग प्रदान किया। इस कार्यक्रम में माननीय उपराष्ट्रपति जी ने जनता को संबोधित करते

A short cultural programme was also held in the auditorium which was commenced with the welcome of chief guest. DRM sir addressed the students with his inspirational words.




## GANDHI JAYANTI

From time to time music and dance event in some form or other are organised in our school. Monthly activities are also organised in the school. Children also participated




Our school provides our students with an opportunity to




## ARTICLE ON Asian Games 2023

With an unprecedent haul of 107 medals that included 28 Gold, 38 Silver and 41 Bronze medals, India set a new benchmark for themselves at the Asian Games 2023 in Hangzhou the people's Republic of China.

It was the first time in Asian Games History, that Medal tally crossed the three-figure mark. By doing so, they become the only fourth country after China, Japan & the Republic of Korea to win 100 or more Medal in a single edition of the Asian Games.




Let's now learn about some amazing achievements of ISRO.

1. Satellite Launch Vehicle (SLV) was launched in 1970 under the guidance of Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam.
2. Chandrayan, Indian first space mission to the moon in 2008.
3. There Bacteria Species were found in the year 2009, which have high resistance to the UV rays.
4. PSLVC21 Rocket was launched in 2012, which placed two satellites in the Earth's Orbit.
5. Mars Orbiter Mission in 2013 was one of the biggest achievements of ISRO.
6. In the year 2014, India reached Mars successfully in its first attempt.
7. ISRO launched GSLV MK3 in 2014 that can take human beings to space.
8. ISRO launched 104 Satellite from a SINGLE ROCKET IN 2017.
9. In 2017, ISRO also launched GSLV-F09, which helped to provide one of the biggest communication networks in South Asia.
10. With NAVIC or Navigation with Indian Constellation for operation, India come under one of the 5 countries that owns a navigation system.

The first known Olympic contest took place in the stadium Olympia in 766 B.C. This stadium stood in the valley of Olympia in western Greece. It has room for 40,000 spectators. For many years, the Olympics were for male contestants and male spectators only. They were held every four years.
3. The Roman Empire conquered Greece during the 100's B.C., and the games soon lost their religious meaning. The contestants became interested only in winning money. In A.D. 394, Emperor Theodosius ordered the games ended because of their great decline in quality. No Olympics were held for more than 1,500 years.
4. The first modern Olympic Games took place in Athens, Greece, in 1896. Women first competed in the modern games in 1900. No games were held in 1916, 1940, or 1944 because of World Wars I and II.
5. The modern Olympics were organized to encourage world peace and friendship and to promote amateur athletics. The Olympic symbol consists of five interlocking rings that represent the continents of Africa, Asia, Australia, Europe, and North and South America. The rings are black, blue, green, red, and yellow. The flag of every nation competing in the games has at least one of these colors.

चन्द्रयान-3 के सफलतापूर्वक प्रक्षेपण के बाद आदित्य L-1 नामक उपग्रह को सफलतापूर्वक भेजा गया।

आज हमारे वैज्ञानिक पूर्णतया अपने ही संसाधनों एवं तकनीक से अंतरिक्ष विज्ञान में सफलता के लिए सक्रिय हैं, यह हमारे लिए गौरव का विषय है।
